GUIDELINES FOR BODY DONATION

Donating body after death for educational purposes is an act of serving humanity.

- 👉 To serve the humanity and to become a proud body donor, an affidavit as per the attached format needs to be submitted in stamp paper worth Rs.100/- to the Professor, Department of Anatomy, Government Medical College, Manjeri.
- 👉 Consent from all the legal heirs of the donor is mandatory. If there are no relatives, it should be specified.
- 👉 All legal heirs and two witnesses should mandatorily sign the document.
- 👉 Photos (2) & copy of Aadhaar card of donor along with Aadhaar card copies of all heirs and witnesses should be submitted.
- 👉 The donor on submission of the above documents a registered **"Body Donor ID Card"** will be issued which should be informed to close friends and all relatives. This card must be carried at all times.
- 👉 Within six hours after death the dead body should be brought to the Government Medical College, Manjeri. If it takes more than six hours, the body should be kept in a freezer and brought to the Anatomy Department. Ambulance facility will be arranged.
- 👉 We regret to inform you that dead bodies subjected to post-mortem cannot be accepted even if they are registered for donation with ID card.
